

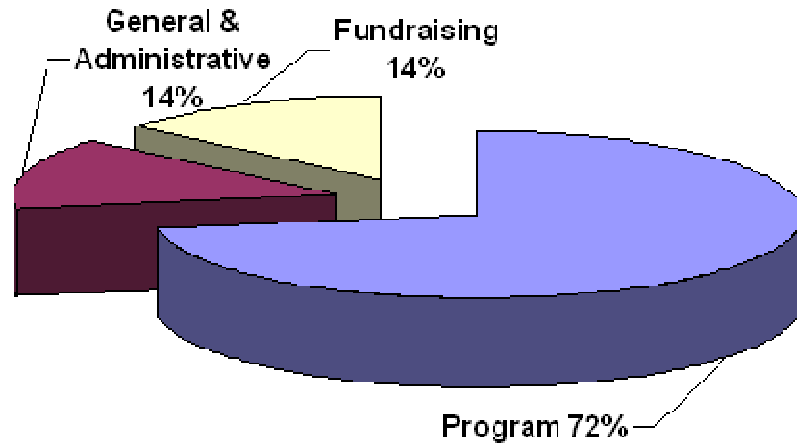

### Functional Expenses



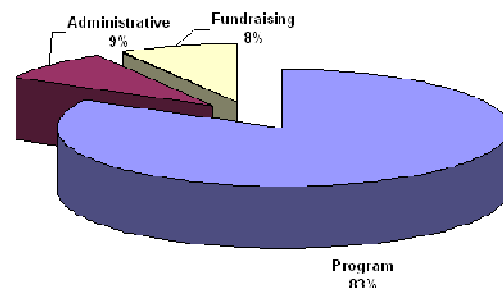

### Finances: Another Look\*

Sometimes it's difficult to understand your financial investment by looking strictly at a financial statement or summary (above), so we have calculated the impact (in dollars) our numerous volunteers are making.

Mileage at 14 cents/mile (standard rate)	335.500 miles	= \$46,970
Food donations at \$3-\$8 per meal (standard rate)	19,293 meals	= \$99,512
Volunteer hours at \$20.25/hour (standard rate)	17,340 hours	= \$384,446
<b>Total Volunteer impact in dollars</b>		<b>= \$668,484</b>

Dear friends,

It is thrilling to be a part of God's work among internationals in this generation. God is sending the world's future leaders in ever-increasing numbers from among the least-evangelized nations. When internationals from these nations come to the US to study, they are open to relationships and open to hear the

gospel. Those that receive the gospel are trained and return home to extend the kingdom of God in amazing ways. We believe that sending these self-supporting, language-proficient, culturally adapted, relationally connected, personally trained witnesses among the nations is one of the most strategic, effective, and low-cost ways to fulfill the great commission given by Jesus Christ. And God has opened wide the door of service for American Christians to get involved through IFI, just as He has opened wide the hearts of internationals to hear the good news and receive discipleship training.

As you can see in this annual report, IFI is significantly engaging the international community and mobilizing and training the church. But numbers cannot adequately convey the impact of this ministry. It is understood through the stories of students like Y, who returned to a country hostile to the gospel to bring the good news to his people. At risk to his life he has seen God's hand of favor as two new churches among Muslims have been planted, refugees have been helped, and a community center established. Y attributes his return to his country as a direct result of God speaking to him via the discipleship training he received through IFI.

Thank you for being a part of this great move of God. Your partnership is vital as we seek to expand the IFI ministry to new areas and as we seek to increase the number of students reached and volunteers trained.

### Who IFI is reaching...\*

- There are over 3,500 international students at OSU, but over 5,000 international students, and scholars and family members in all Columbus colleges and universities.
- 850 of these students were personally served in some way by IFI in 2008.

### How IFI is reaching them...

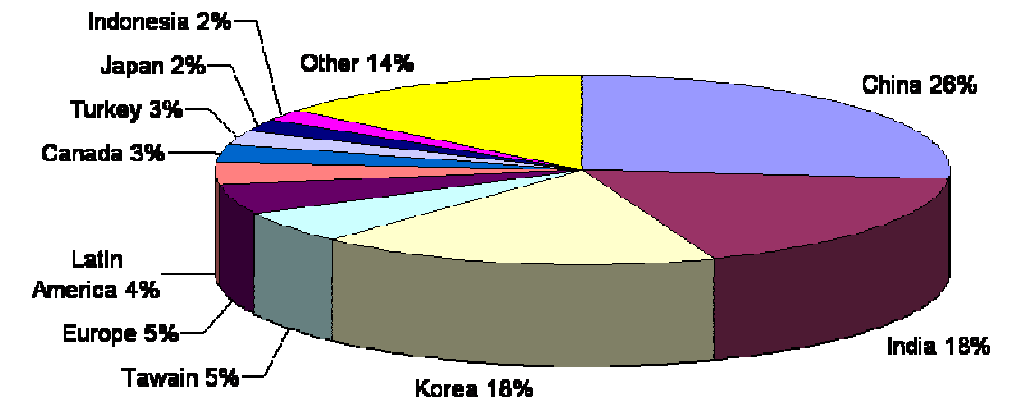
- At least 40% of the *new* students were served by IFI
- Airport pick up and/or temporary housing: 302 students
- English Conversation Partners: 236 students
- IFI trips: 217 students
- Garage Sale Shopping: 180 students
- English as a Second Language: 75 students
- Friendship Partners: 72 students
- International Wives Group: 20 students
- International Mom's Group: 30 students
- Bible Study Groups: 195 students
- Discipleship Training: 20 students
- 20 international students came to faith in Jesus Christ, including students from China, India, Malaysia, Vietnam, Korea, Madagascar, Mexico, and Japan
- Internationals for God's Kingdom Training Conference: 100 students
