1. REGISTRATION WITH THE OFFICE OF INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS (OIA) in the Ohio Union (Building #161 on the campus map) 1739 N. High St., Columbus, OH 43210
 - A. Students must check in to pick up schedule and **sign up to attend an orientation session** that covers a variety of topics and student concerns such as Academic Success, Opening a Bank Account, Banking and Investment, Family session, Health and Health Insurance, Buses and Parking, Computer Session, Education Session, Library Tour, Off-Campus Housing, and Women's Issues
 - B. OIA also provides **OSU CAMPUS TOURS** and a handbook that is very helpful for their needs in Columbus.
 - C. Other information will be given at the check-in related to student ID's, social security cards, etc.
