



Information on Providing Potlucks for Friday night Bible study

Here is what you can expect when you volunteer to provide dinner for our Friday night Bible study:

- Each small group has members bring one main dish and one side dish (rice, vegetable, fruit, or dessert). Each dish needs to serve 10-12 people. Within each group please make sure some members prepare vegetarian dishes, plain white rice, and only a few desserts. **All together, 75 to 100 people (other than your group) are served dinner at the Friday night Bible study.**
- Volunteer groups arrive at **Columbus First Church of the Nazarene (142 King Avenue Columbus 43201) 6.45pm.**
- Students begin to arrive for dinner at 7pm.
- Volunteer group *provides one person to share their three minute testimony on how they met Jesus.*
- Volunteers are welcomed to stay for the bible study portion of our evening *but are asked to sit and listen rather than participate.*
- You do not need to provide paper products (napkins, cups, plates or silverware) or drinks.
