Lucy's Story

Two local volunteers planted the seed, others watered, but God caused the growth in Lucy over nine years.

"Lucy" was one of six Chinese students whom Gene and Phyllis Greene of Columbus OH hosted in fall 2007. All six attended the Greenes' Bible discussion, and one received Christ. Lucy did not, but she did volunteer frequently in the IFI office in Columbus. The staff found her very outgoing, her English quite good, and her help welcome.

When Lucy graduated from the Fisher School of Business at The Ohio State University in 2010, she got a job in the US. Several years ago, she went to Northwestern University for a master's degree. During her last year at Northwestern, she asked the Greenes for copies of the songs they had sung at their Bible study; those songs kept going through her mind, she said.

After she got her master's in 2016, Lucy


and her husband, an American, moved to Bloomington IL, where she started attending the local Chinese church and Bible Study Fellowship. In October 2016, Lucy wrote to the Greenes, "Everything I'm learning at the Chinese church and BSF agrees with what you taught us. It has started to sink in."

Just before Thanksgiving, she told the Greenes she had accepted Christ several weeks before. Her husband's parents had invited them to Columbus for Thanksgiving; could they stop by to see the Greenes?

Again and again, God shows faithful IFI staff and volunteers, "It's not important who does the planting or who does the watering. What's important is that God makes the seed grow." (1 Corinthians 3:7 NLT) Gene and Phyllis say "Amen!" to that!
